Conference travel and travel grants for PhD students in Chinese/Sinology

Lund University invites applications for conference/workshop/field research travel grants for PhD students in Chinese from the Birgit Rausing Language Programme. The grants are intended to cover costs associated with conference/workshop/field research travel, alternatively, costs for participation in an online conference/workshop. An application reg. a conference/workshop may concern participation only, or participation including a presentation connected to the applicant's project/paper.

Fields

Research on the Chinese language and/or culture and society.

Eligibility

The applicant must be admitted to a PhD programme in Chinese at Lund University at the deadline for applications.

First priority will be given to eligible applicants who started their PhD studies during the last two years and second priority to eligible applicants who did not yet receive any funding from the Birgit Rausing Language Programme.

Conditions

- The conference/workshop/field trip that the application concerns is to take place 31 December 2022 at the latest.
- The grant may cover costs for travel and accommodation, and compensation for increased living expenses in accordance with Swedish Tax Agency calculations of international subsistence allowances, as well as participation fees and other costs connected to the conference/workshop/field research.
- Any other funding for which the applicant has applied or which he/she has been granted for the same purpose must be listed in the application.
- The grants may not be used towards salaries.
- A report on the research and use of funds is to be submitted to the management group of the Birgit Rausing Language Programme no later than one month after the conference/workshop/field research trip.

Application

The written application shall include the following documents:

- CV
- Ladok transcript
- Research plan (max. 4 pages)
- Certificate from the supervisor stating the purpose of the applicant's participation in the conference/workshop.

- If applicable: Correspondence confirming the acceptance of the applicant's paper/presentation at the conference/workshop
- If applicable: Certificate from the host institution that it can receive the applicant
- Budget/calculated costs

The application should be submitted via email, including attachments in pdf-format. The subject of the email should be 'The Birgit Rausing Language Programme' and the reference number stated above.

The application must have reached the management group of the Birgit Rausing Language Programme no later than 30 November 2021.

Decision

A decision will be made by the board of the Birgit Rausing Language Programme on 8 December 2021.
